- Estimate based on style

This listing is not intended to follow full descriptive bibliographic conventions. Thus where the date has any sort of collaboration (e.g. advertisement of publication or copyright registration) it is considered to be confirmed. Where no collaboration has been able to be found and an estimate is given, this is indicated by comment “estimated date” in the notes column.

First editions only are included, except where a later edition involved a change of publisher.
